# **RESOLUTION NO. 3 OF 2004**



# DISPUTE PROCEDURE ON CASES EMANATING FROM RESOLUTION 7/2002 OF THE PSCBC

## 1. Scope

- 1.1 This agreement binds:
  - (a) the employer;
  - (b) the employees of the employer who are members of the trade union parties to this agreement; and
  - (c) the employees of the employer who are not members of any trade union party to this agreement, but who fall within the registered scope of Council.

#### 2. Parties note that:

- 2.1 Paragraph 10.4 of the PSCBC Resolution 7/2002 allows a party to refer the dispute emanating from the said Resolution to the PSCBC or the relevant sectoral council.
- 2.2 The PSCBC has taken a decision to refer disputes regarding application of the said resolution to various sectoral councils.
- 2.3 The PSCBC will further fund the costs of adjudication of the said disputes.

### 3. Parties therefore agree that:

- 3.1 All disputes that arose as a result of the application of the Resolution 7/2002, will be dealt with through the dispute resolution procedures of the PHWSBC.
- 3.2 This agreement will come into effect on the date of signing.

# 4. Dispute resolution:

4.1 Dispute about the interpretation or application of this agreement shall be dealt with in terms of the Council's dispute resolution procedures.
