



# **RESOLUTION 2 OF 2012**

AGREEMENT ON THE OCCUPATIONAL SPECIFIC DISPENSATION FOR ENGINEERS, TECHNOLOGISTS, TECHNICIANS, ARTISANS AND SCIENTISTS EMPLOYED IN THE PUBLIC HEALTH SECTOR

## 1. OBJECTIVES

The objective of this agreement is to extend the following resolutions of the General Public Service Sectoral Bargaining Council (GPSSBC) to the Public Health and Social Development Sectoral Bargaining Council (PHSDSBC) as per directive from the Minister of Public Service and Administration dated 23 March 2012:

- 1.1 Resolution 3 of 2009: Quantity Surveyor, Professional Surveyors, Architects, Regional Town Planners, GISC Professionals, Scientists (all categories covered by this Resolution)
- 1.2 Resolution 4 of 2009: Artisans (all categories covered by this Resolution)
- 1.3 Resolution 5 of 2009: Engineering, Surveyors, Architectural Draughts Personnel, GIS and Scientific Technicians (all categories covered by this Resolution)
- 1.4 Resolution 6 of 2009: Engineering, Architectural, GIS and Quantity Surveyor Technologists (all categories covered by this resolution)
- 1.5 Resolution 9 of 2009: Engineers (all categories covered by this resolution)

# 2. SCOPE

This agreement applies to:

- 2.1. The State as Employer;
- 2.2. The employees of the Employer who are members of the trade unions parties to this agreement and;
- 2.3 Those employees who are not members of the said trade unions.

- 3.1.3 Resolution 5 of 2009: Engineers, Surveyors, Architectural Draughts Personnel, GIS and Scientific Technicians (all categories covered by this resolution)
- 3.1.4 Resolution 6 of 2009: Engineers, Architects, GIS and Quantity Surveyor Technologists (all categories covered by this resolution)
- 3.1.5 Resolution 9 of 2009: Engineers (all categories covered by this resolution)

#### 4. DATE OF IMPLEMENTATION

This agreement shall be implemented retrospective from 01 July 2009.

#### 5. INTERPRETATION AND APPLICATION

- 5.1 In the event of any conflict between the provisions of this agreement and any other agreement of the Council, the provisions of this agreement shall take precedence.
- 5.2 No amendments to this agreement shall be of force of effect unless reduced to writing and agreed upon by the parties to the Council as a resolution of the Council.
